Danny W. Williams, 82, received eternal rest and peace on January 16, 2018 at Christian Northeast Hospital.

He was born April 27, 1935 in Alton, Illinois to the late Arnett Williams and Virginia (Hyndman) Williams. He graduated from Alton Senior High School in 1954. After graduation he enlisted in the United States Army where he was stationed in Western Europe. During his service, he held the Army's Welterweight Champion title for all of Western Europe.

After an honorable discharge, he returned to Alton. Then after, he was united in holy matrimony to Gail (nee Gersman) Williams on November 19, 1960. He then moved to St. Louis and attended Hadley Tech for auto-mechanics and worked within the field for several years. In 1964, he joined the St. Louis Fire Dept. Company at Engine House # 11, where he served his entire career until he retired in July of 1989.

After retirement, he continued to do what he enjoyed: working on anything from a car to lawnmower. Even with his numerous hospital stays, you could not get him to stop moving his hands as he persisted to fix anything and everything he deemed to be broken. He was never idle.

In addition to his wife of 57 years, he is survived by his two children: Steven J.

Williams of St. Louis, MO. and Melissa A. Williams-Tauriac of Dallas, TX; three grandchildren: Jerron A. Benson (Charre) of St. Louis, MO., Leah A. Tauriac, of Dallas, TX., and Lauren A. Tauriac of Dallas, TX; four great-grandchildren; two sisters: Karen Swanson, of Alton, IL., Joan Williams- Alton, IL.; two brothers: Benny Williams of St. Louis, MO, Gary Williams of Elgin, IL.; as well as a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and special friends.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by six brothers: Roy, Bernard, Arnett Jr., Lloyd, Lamond, Jimmy; and his dear sister Sarah.
