June 14, 1930 - May 29, 2020

Estella M Beckmann (nee Murillo) Age 89 of Florissant, was born June 14, 1930 in El Paso, TX. She graduated from El Paso High School in 1948. She married William (Bill) A Beckmann Jr. on August 18, 1956 and moved to St. Louis.
