



## Ferl Fredrick Toll

April 9, 1931 - December 1, 2020

Ferl Toll, 89, of Florissant, MO passed away on December 1, 2020.

Ferl was born in 1931 in Elder, KS to Otto and Thelma Toll née Berg, moving to his ancestral home of De Soto, MO while still a child. He completed his education at De Soto High School with honors in Mathematics. Upon leaving High School, Ferl began work at Dependable Appliance Service Inc until its acquisition by Sears in 1974 and would continue with them until his retirement in 1994. He would not rest after retirement however, regularly traveling around the continental United States to visit family and friends, always in search of a fishing spot. In his later years he took to philanthropy; donating money to charities too numerous to mention, even doing a history presentation for the De Soto Historical Society to address incongruencies that were accumulated throughout the years.

Ferl is survived by his son Bruce Toll; his six grandchildren: Lisa Marie Michaelis, James Leach, Melissa Villa (Julio), John Gregory Klaus, Nathan Toll, and Matthew Toll; seven great-grandchildren: Ashley Wells, Danni Grant (Joe), Howard Linvel Grant Jr., Thomas Aubuchon, Jacob Villa, Julia Villa, and Patrick Carr; as well as five great-great-grandchildren: Sophia Andrew, Isabella Wells, Benjamin Brandt, Joseph Braddy Jr., and Chance James Braddy. Ferl Toll is preceded in death by his wife of 42 years Delores Singen (d. 1994); as well as daughters Maureen (d. 2001) and Mary Ellen (d. 1963); and great-great-granddaughter Annabelle Andrews (d. 2010)
