George was born in Sanger CA where his family was one of Sanger’s pioneer farm families. He graduated with a B.S. in Civil Engineering from U.C. Berkeley in 1941. In 1942 George and his family were sent to an internment camp in Poston AZ. He was allowed to leave the camp in 1943. George moved to Cleveland, OH, and then to Detroit, MI, in 1944 where he married Skeets. He served in the U.S. Army from 1944-1946 and was assigned to help rebuild Berlin. After discharge George and Skeets settled in the St. Louis area where George worked for Horner & Shifrin Consulting Engineers and was a prominent member of the Japanese American community.
