Looking back, like when I'm talking to Kris or Kerri, sometimes we recap the past year or 2, and we think wow, you know, this could have all gone so differently. God put it into play so we could be there, could do the things we always did, even down to making your fave meal right before you went into the hospital. There were no accidents in that plan. (I'm not saying I don't fault the hospital for anything - I just believe God knew all that would happen and did the best He could to prepare us, even though we had no

idea at the time) When I look at that, I see prayers were answered. You didn't die on June 15th as the hospital tried to get us to let you go. You rallied through, to the point of nearly coming home. Yes, we did end up losing you in September, but even that I think was a gift from God in such that if you had died in June, how could we ever understand that? Two days after admission? God let us have those 3 extra months with you. We all got to spend so much time with you, talk to you about stuff, etc. In the end, we had to make the choice for you, but at that point we knew you were tired. We knew we had exhausted all medical means to try to bring you back to us. I'm not sure if what I'm trying to say is coming across right, Mom, but when I think I couldn't possibly be any sadder, any more hurt than I am, I think back to wow, if God had taken Mom in June, I really would be worse than I am now. I hope that makes sense. We all got to be there with you, which was a blessing for sure. We were always scared you might pass away when it was just one of us there. I think back to how you always prayed you wouldn't die at home. Just so many prayers actually were answered, just not in the timing we would have liked. I think it was just 2-1/2 hours later you were sick again, and we had to take you to the hospital. It was one of the worst hospital stays you ever had because you were painfully aware each day. You were awake the whole time, never losing consciousness like you did in this last stay. It was hard to see and hear you in pain. We weren't used to you vocalizing pain. We got you home, though. You said you would never go back to a hospital again, and I think we all agreed that we understood that. However, you were so sick in June. I truly know in my heart that if I hadn't gotten you to the



hospital, you would have died that very day in your room and the fact that you didn't is something we all will always be grateful for. I know this summer had to be tough on you, even if you couldn't express it to us. I know how much it wore us all down, but we would do it a million times over, Mom, and I know you know that. I'm glad we had time to talk, even if those talks were just you mouthing sentences. You got good at it, and we got good at reading your lips. 



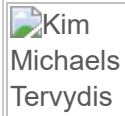

just a dream, or did Mom actually come into my dream? I pray it's the former. I love you my sweet girl. I miss you to my core. I love you always, your Kimi Pie

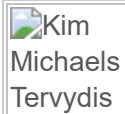

We'd ask how you are, and you were always "perfect." I don't know how you did it. I'm not nearly that strong. I admire you so much. You have such strength, such fight, such compassion, such selflessness, and if you ask me, you had every reason to complain, but you never would. Never. I can tell I'm depressed. I'm doing counseling, but I just don't think there is enough counseling to be had. Lisa calls me often, as does Mike, but really I don't hear from anyone anymore. I think that's the way it goes. People are there for the hard part, which is much appreciated (the visitation and funeral), but then they tend to kind of fade off. It sucks. However, maybe I can't even talk to them really. It's all I can do to even have a conversation with my sisters without one of us breaking down. I'm looking for some grief support groups in town that may help. I feel like I need to be around people and not doing online grief support really. I love you, Mommy. So much. I miss you immensely. I have to go check Facebook to make sure this



*doesn't post there. I like having a place where I can talk to just you.
