Lorene Wesley-Proctor, the second of five children of the late Collie and Fannie Bell Wesley, was born December 29, 1946 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas. Her parents and one sister preceded her in death.

She was educated in Pine Bluff at C.P. Coleman High School. She graduated from the University of Arkansas with a Bachelor Degree in Business Education. She accepted Christ at an early age and became a member of Highland Baptist Church, the late Rev. S.B. Scott, Pastor. She moved to St. Louis in 1966. She was United in Holy Matrimony to Floyd Proctor Jr. in 1967. To this union four sons were born.

She was employed at Washington University as a Secretary and later employed at Chrysler Corporation as an Inventory Analyst and retired after 30 years.

She joined Mt. Olive Baptist Church, under the leadership of the late Rev. Langford. She served as a Sunday School Teacher, Choir Member and in the Women's Ministry.

She later became a member of Revival Center, C.O.G.I.C, Rev. Bessie Brown, Pastor, where she served as an Assistant to the Pastor.

Lorene joined Christ Holiness Temple in 1991 and was ordained an Elder in 2000. She was a dedicated, committed, faithful member and a great encourager, serving as Sunday School Teacher, President of the Mission Department and an Associate Minister.

She departed this life Sunday, September 30, 2012 at home surrounded by her family.

She leaves to cherish her memories; a devoted husband, Floyd Proctor Jr.; four devoted and caring sons, Kennard Proctor, St. Louis, MO; Anthony Proctor (Judy) Mt.
