Michael Layton, 56, of Florissant, MO, passed away on Tuesday February 17, 2015 surrounded by family and friends, fortified with the Sacraments of the Holy Church.

Michael, son of Caroline (Keen) and the late Allen Layton. Brother to Daniel (deceased), Thomas and Jean. Brother-in-law to Linda (Worley) Layton. Dear uncle to Sean, Brandon, Allen, Christopher and Kaitlyn. Cousin and friend of too many to list.

Michael attended Ladue High School, St. Mary's Community College and Lindenwood University. He worked for and was part owner of Tractor Trailer Supply Co. for the past 30+ years. Whether it was basketball, softball, golf, The Blues, Cardinals, Rams, Missouri Tigers or a Bob Seger concert, his love for these things was undeniable.

Michael, who was deaf, played for or was involved with many different deaf clubs and organizations. Just to mention a couple: MAAD, Midwest Athletic Association for the Deaf, and the MinnePaul Softball Club. He was also part of the 1985 USA Deaf Olympic Gold Medal Winning Basketball Team.

Michael was such a caring and giving individual with a unique personality who touched so many peoples' lives that he came into contact with over the course of his life. He didn't let his handicap keep him from living life to its fullest. He will always be remembered, but never forgotten.

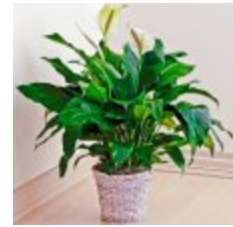
