



## Michael J. Montague PhD

December 25, 1947 - May 17, 2025

Born on December 25, 1947, in Flint Michigan, Michael James Montague earned his Ph.D. in cellular and molecular biology from The University of Michigan in 1974. Following postdoctoral studies at Stanford University in 1975, he began a 40-year research career with several major corporations, working on both the improvement of agricultural productivity and in pharmaceutical discovery. Additionally, he worked as a research manager, science communicator, author, and lecturer. He participated on teams of research scientists who made major contributions that now benefit billions of people globally. In addition to science, his other passion was music, and he performed as a card-carrying union musician in many bands, orchestras, and pit orchestras in St. Louis and Denver as a woodwind instrumentalist. In that capacity, Dr. Montague performed a wide variety of types of music, as well as arranging and composing music. He studied performance and music theory with several accomplished musicians and teachers at Webster University in St. Louis and at the

University of Denver. He

is the author of two published books on the interface between science and music.

Michael has enjoyed several wonderful friendships and partnerships, including his partner,

Ken Webster, Glen Miller, Phil Clark, Wade Cadle, and Joe Keller. He had two younger brothers,

Daniel H. Montague and James K. Montague (deceased), and is predeceased by his parents Ella

M. Montague and Herbert F. Montague, Jr.
