Monica E. Husbands, 74 of Florissant, MO. Beloved Wife, Mother, Grandmother family member and friend. Monica Elaine Husbands' sunrise was February 26, 1942 in Georgetown, Guyana, South America. She graduated from Central High School in Georgetown two years early. After completing her studies, she worked for the Guyanese government. She later obtained her Doctorate of Divinity from Kingsway Theological Seminary and Bible School and left government work for the ministry.

Monica married John Husbands on September 8, 1962, and they both entered full-time ministry dedicating their lives to the work of the Lord. Led by God's plan, ministry work took her from Guyana to the United States in 1972; then to Canada in 1980 where they served as Missionaries. They returned to the United States in 1990 where God planted them in St. Louis, Missouri. In the course of service to the Lord, they traveled to South Africa, Jamaica, Barbados, and Israel. Monica's adult life was spent doing God's work and serving those around her. Her life was devoted to making a difference in the lives of everyone she touched.

Monica was an outstanding wife, serving alongside her husband, John for 53+ years, in the work of the Lord. She was also a devoted and loving mother to her six children and a comforting and supportive grandmother to her eighteen grandchildren.

She is survived by her amazing, loving and devoted husband, Dr. John Husbands Sr., her eldest child and only son Rev. John Husbands Jr. (Rebecca
