Priscilla De Vine, a woman whose heart was as big as her family and whose voice was as vibrant as her spirit, passed away on April 24, 2026. Born on September 14, 1934, in Flat River, Missouri, to George and Blanche Gilman, Priscilla lived a life defined by deep faith, an infectious wit, and an unwavering devotion to those she loved.

For over 75 years, Priscilla walked hand-in-hand with her devoted husband, Robert D. De Vine. Together, they built a sprawling, lively legacy that spanned five generations. While she was preceded in death by her parents and her beloved children, Stephen and Susan, and her grandson, Todd Moore; her spirit lives on through her surviving children: Michael, John, Robert (Jennifer), Mary Silver (Mark), and Laura De Vine. She also leaves behind a legion of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren who will forever miss her affection and the sharp humor that could light up any room.

To Priscilla, family was everything. Whether it was a holiday gathering filled with her famous recipes and new culinary creations or a rainy afternoon at a ball field, she was there. She was her children's and grandchildren's loudest cheerleader—always present, "win or lose," to offer support from the sidelines of their lives.

Outside of the home, Priscilla was a woman of many passions. She was a dedicated fan of the NFL, but her truest joy was found in song. She was a fixture in the local karaoke scene, often found sharing the mic and a laugh with her daughters and friends.

Her career at DePaul Hospital was more than just a job; it was an extension of her Christian faith. Priscilla had a rare gift for connection; she never truly met a stranger, only friends she hadn't talked to yet. At DePaul, she provided a "caring heart and hand" to those in their most vulnerable moments, a role she took great pride in and one that left a lasting impact on her community.

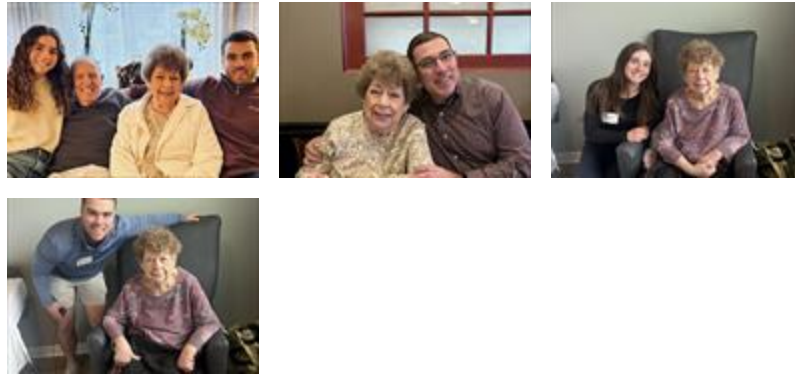

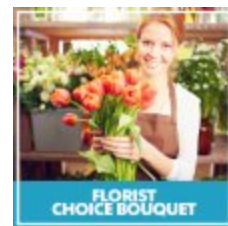
