He received an honorable discharge and moved to Chicago, Illinois. He worked in construction and relocated to St. Louis, Missouri where he began his own business, Jack's Bricklaying in the early 1960's. He joined the Greater Mount Carmel Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Earl E. Nance, Sr. where he sang in the Male Chorus, Inspirational Chorus, and the Vocal Choir, he was a Church School Teacher, he became a deacon and later accepted the call into the ministry and was an ordained minister.
